- Baking Soda (BS)

Solution = 1 cup of water + 2 table spoons of BS

Paste = 1 table spoon of water + 3 table spoons of BS

- Sea salt

- Water

- Vinegar

Electronics	Materials	Tools	Directions
Microwave	Baking soda	Small container Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mix a cup of water + a spoon of baking soda into a container • Microwave this mix for a minute • Take out the container • Wipe inside with a dried cloth.
Food mixer	Baking soda	-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add some water + a spoon of baking soda • Operate it as usual.
Rice cooker	Solution of baking soda	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wipe its surface with a wet cloth.
Floor lamp	Solution of baking soda	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wipe its surface with a dried cloth then wipe its bulb with a wet cloth and dry it.

Others	Materials	Tools	Directions
Tables, chairs	Solution of baking soda	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wipe them with a wet cloth.
Fabric sofa, cushions	Baking soda	Vacuum cleaner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add baking soda all over them • leave them for a few hours • Vacuum.
wooden shelf	Solution of baking soda	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wipe them with a wet cloth. • wipe them with a dried cloth • try not make stains on them
Silver ware, Cups, Dishes	Paste of baking soda	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare for a cup first and make paste into it as the photo above shows.

Kitchen	Materials	Tools	Directions
Refrigerator	Solution of baking soda	A piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wipe its inside & outside with a wet cloth.
	Baking soda	-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To remove a smell, put a cup of baking soda and keep it inside for a few hours.
Fan	Solution of baking soda	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wipe a fan with a wet cloth and make it dry
Gas stove	Paste of baking soda	-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare for a cup first and put some baking soda and a few drops of water then stir
		Old toothbrush Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put the paste on gas stove and brush it with an old toothbrush • After that, wipe everything with a dried cloth.
Sink	Baking soda	Old toothbrush Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put baking soda on sink and brush while adding some water. • Wipe it with a dried cloth.
Drain	Baking soda & vinegar	-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put some baking soda and vinegar on it and leave it for 30 min • Flush with hot boiled water



Green Cleaning - Recipes

Bathroom	Materials	Tools	Directions
Toilet	Hot water	Brush	To get rid of calcium: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add a kettle of hot boiled water and brush it.
	Baking soda	Brush	To clean its surface: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add some baking soda directly and brush it.
Bathtub	Baking soda or sea salt	Sponge	To clean fur: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scrub with baking soda/ sea salt.
	Baking soda & vinegar	Old toothbrush	To get rid of mold: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put some vinegar on it directly and add some baking soda on it. • Scrub it with an old toothbrush and rinse with cold water.
Drain	Baking soda & vinegar	-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unplug and remove stuck hair • Put some baking soda and vinegar. • Leave the bubbles for 30 min • Rinse with hot boiled water
Sink	Baking soda	Brush	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add some baking soda and brush its surface
	Vinegar	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put vinegar on faucet • Wipe with a piece of cloth

Rooms	Materials	Tools	Directions
Floor	Solution of baking soda	Piece of cloth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wipe its surface with a wet cloth
Carpet	Baking soda	Vacuum cleaner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add baking soda all over them and • Leave them for a few hours • Vacuum
Windows	-	Newspaper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crumple a piece of newspaper and • Soak in water and squeeze it • Wipe window with it and make it dry.
